NEW BUSINESSES IN TALBOTTON

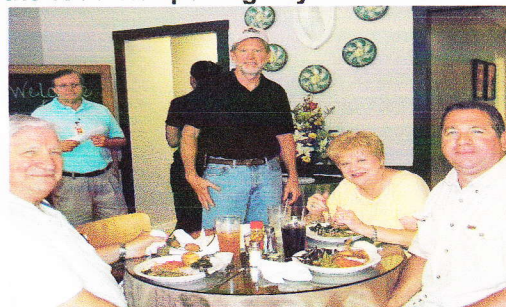
